This application is for a water berth at Alameda Marina. The application must be filled out completely and must be accompanied by:

1. Boats coming into the marina must supply CURRENT DMV REGISTRATION FOR CALIFORNIA and at least 8 different pictures of the boat taken within the last month.
2. Boats purchased from existing tenants must have Vessel Title with current registration from previous owner and bill of sale, or current DMV registration in new owner's name.
3. Proof of insurance: An official insurance company document showing:
  - a. Policy ID
  - b. Expiration Date at least 3 months in the future
  - c. Liability Coverage for at least \$250,000 per incident

**We are not accepting U.S. Coast Guard documented vessels at this time.**

Applicant must be able to receive bills at a physical address. **We do not send bills to P.O. boxes** and we do not rent space to persons without a physical home address. "In Care of" addresses must be evaluated by the harbormaster.

Alameda Marina does not do automatic billing.

**Please read the following carefully:**

- 1 No wooden boats are allowed.
- 2 No junk boats. Boats should generally have value according to the following approximate schedule:

Size Range	Type	Value
Less than 25'	Power	Not Accepting
Less than 25'	Sail	\$1,500
Less than 30'	Sail/power	\$5,000
Less than 32'	Power or Sail	\$10,000
Less than 36'	Power or Sail	\$15,000
Greater than 36'	Power or Sail	\$30,000+

- 3 Boat must be seaworthy (not be taking on water).
- 4 Must be clean; no mildew or dirt on decks, topsides, no tarps on the boat.
- 5 Must have no openings or holes of any kind on decks or cabins without hardware cover.
- 6 Must not have debris or junk on the boat. Only necessary sailing equipment is allowed.
- 7 Boats 20' or longer must have operating propulsion machinery
- 8 Boats greater than 28' need to have working internal auxiliary propulsion machinery. We do not allow boats to be towed into the marina.
- 9 All boats with a head must have a Type I, II, or III marine sanitation device installed.
- 10 All boats MUST comply with USCG minimum equipment and signage regulations.
- 11 All rigging must be intact, masts stepped, and dinghy stored on board.
- 12 We do not accept boats that have significant visible collision or other damage.

Also note: At his discretion, the harbormaster may require a survey of the vessel, and may do a background check or credit check. No credit check will be done without the applicant's permission.

The above documentation may be supplied by email or presented in person. No fax copies will be accepted.
